| Joshua's final years | Joshua was older than Caleb and died not long after <br> the Conquest. |
| :---: | :--- |
| Death of all Joshua's <br> generation | The text actually refers to the "elders" who outlived <br> Joshua (Josh. 24:31; Judg. 2:7). This probably refers <br> to the few not included in the census (Num. 1) who <br> did not die in the wilderness. |
| "410 years" of Judges | Some judges overlapped so that the "410 years" of <br> events are not 410 actual years. |
| Years of Eli's judgeship | Eli overlapped with the other judges (he was also the <br> high priest). |

| ministry |  |$\quad$| Samuel was a younger contemporary of both Samson |

| and Jephthah. Furthermore, he is the last of the judges |
| and lives well into the Monarchy Period. |
